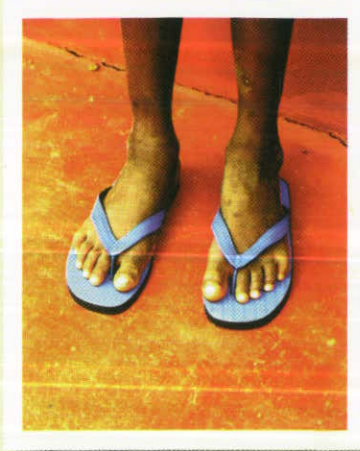

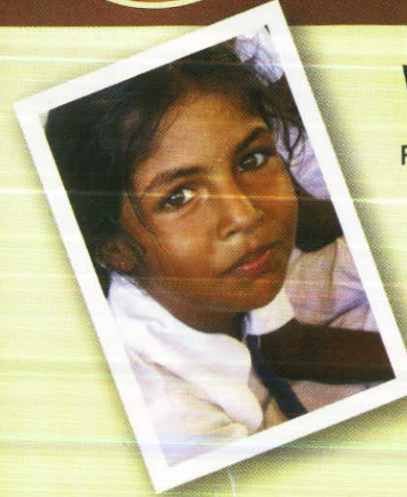

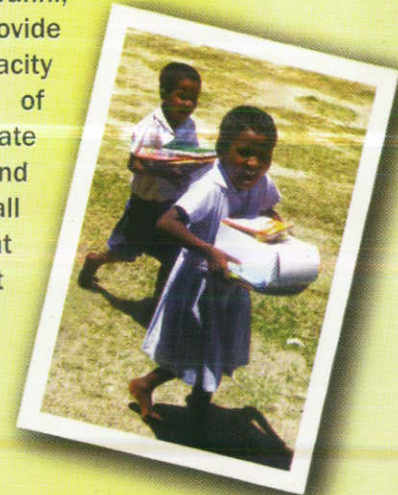
Vision

Specific Goals & Key Objectives

The Unity Mission Team will:

operate on an Inter-faith platform, working in recognition of the multi-plural multi ethnic and multi religious social fabric of our beautiful Motherland.

focus on working with youth, specifically those in the age group of 15 to 20 years.

specifically focus on delivering leadership, personality development and capacity building training and development of the children of the North and the Wanni, particularly amongst those who have suffered much trauma during the years of the conflict in Sri Lanka and foster healing, unity and reconciliation.

will also focus on supporting educational needs of these young children by developing reference libraries, providing school books and other requirements to support class room studies, sports equipment and small scale badly needed infrastructure projects to facilitate school work.

will also keep within its mandate the conduct of medical camps, self-employment and skills development projects for school leavers.



Background & Legal Status

Made up of a group of Professionals and like minded people committed to contributing towards fostering Unity, Reconciliation and healing particularly amongst and between the children of the North, South and elsewhere in Sri Lanka.

The Unity Team is currently structured as a voluntary organisation with a pool of around 30 volunteers available to support ground level projects. In addition the Unity Team also has in affiliation a group of senior consultant and other qualified doctors numbering around 35 persons available to conduct medical camps and or be involved on site as is needed, during the conduct of Unity camps.

The Unity Mission Team is NOT a NGO; nor is it a religious group; It is a body of persons, hitherto, who have worked together in a voluntary capacity as a group of concerned and caring citizens who love Sri Lanka who are working to promote unity and reconciliation.

The Legal structure is Non Profit Trust, governed by a Board of Trustees and a Management Team. The Unity Mission Team, will in due course, recruit full time staff if need be and set aside dedicated premises, with bank accounts and independent auditors.
